HAWAIIAN ISLANDS HUMPBACK WHALE NATIONAL MARINE SANCTUARY HOSTS LECTURE: “First Wind: Clean Energy, Made Here”

The Sanctuary Lecture Series presents Carolyn Unser, the community outreach coordinator for First Wind, which operates wind farms on O‘ahu and Maui. Carolyn conducts grassroots community outreach and works collaboratively with community leaders, citizens, and project stakeholders. She leads tours of the wind power projects, offers educational opportunities and experiences for the public, and ensures that First Wind’s projects are supporting and beneficial to the communities in which they operate. Prior to joining First Wind, she worked at SWCA Environmental Consultants as an environmental scientist where she assisted with the biological assessments of First Wind’s wind power sites on O‘ahu and as a permit compliance monitor during their construction. As a resident of O‘ahu’s North Shore, Carolyn lives in the community that she serves.
